2013 L.A.N.D. Directory to be Distributed





North Dakota Petroleum Council Report

Ron Ness, President of the North Dakota Petroleum Council

ND Oil PAC Golf Tournament

The ND Oil PAC will be hosting a golf tournament at Bully Pulpit on Thursday, August 29, 2013. Registration is open (\$150 for NDPC members, \$200 for non-members). Legislative Update

A couple of things happened at the close of the 2013 Legislative Session that LAND members may find interest in. First, HB 1198, which makes major changes to the oil and gas tax structure, included a non-Bakken/Three Forks new well incentive. This incentive subjects the first 75,000 barrels produced during the first 18 months from the time a well has been drilled and completed outside of the Bakken/Three Forks formations and 10 miles or more outside an established field to a reduced tax rate of 2%. In HB 1352, language was included to require the mineral developer to furnish a mineral owner with a description of the conflict and proposed resolution or the title opinion should the owner and mineral developer disagree over the mineral owner's ownership interest. A study of the feasibility and desirability of the establishment of an energy corridor in the western portion of the state was also amended into SB 2018.

Center in Houston, Texas.

The newest of the NAPE events is NAPE Rockies. It will be held

December 11th through the 14th at the Colorado Convention Center.

AAPL has hired a Government
Relations Officer. Her name is
Holly Carless. Holly came highly
recommended and has a
impressive background, work
experience and education that
will benefit our organization. Her
job is to coordinate AAPL's effort
to keep up with the legislation in
various jurisdictions throughout
the country. She will work closely
with the Legislative/Regulatory

Membership is now over 19,000,
which is a 50% increase from
2011.

Education activity tripled since 2008. Accreditation of two new universities was given to the University of Wyoming and West Virginian University.

The CPL exam has been revised.

It had not been updated since the 1980's. The Certification

Committee processed approximately 800 CPL, RPL, and RL applications. There are now 4000 CPLs, 4200 RPLs, and 1500 RL.
